Abstract: The Easton Church Collection, dates from 1821 to 2015 and contains information on or photographs of every church in Easton regardless of denomination. Included in this collection are: annual reports, meeting minutes, directories, historical accounts, play programs, worship programs, advertisements, newspaper articles, correspondence and constitution drafts.

Biographical Note

The traditional New England religions were the main ones in Easton. These included: Congregational, Methodist and Presbyterian. Each denomination gained support due to religious conflicts that caused separations in beliefs. It was with the arrival of the three main immigrant groups: Irish Catholics, Swedish Protestants and Portuguese Catholics, that even more denominations would gain popularity in the town. These immigrants came to Easton in order to work at the Ames Shovel Shops and the Ames Estates. They formed two Catholic parishes and three Swedish churches, paving the way for the religious diversity that the town now enjoys.

In these early days of the town, churches were the social centers. They provided activities, dances, shopping bazaars and suppers, to name a few of the more popular events. Various churches also sponsored Cub Scout and Girl Scout troops, and other social groups that worked to benefit the community through fundraising and volunteering. Immigrant groups found that engaging in church activities helped them to fit into the community and find their respective niches.

Scope and Content Note

The Easton Church Collection, dates from 1821 to 2015 and contains information on or photographs of every church in Easton regardless of denomination. Included in this collection are: annual reports, meeting minutes, directories, historical accounts, play programs, worship programs, advertisements, newspaper articles, correspondence and constitution drafts. This collection is arranged into four subgroups by denomination with subsequent series, subseries, subsubseries and file levels being organized by alphabetical order, chronology, or document genre, as will be specified below. Notable materials in this collection include: photographs of the interior of the Square Top Methodist Church, correspondence between the Lutheran Lebanon Church and their parishioners during wartime.

Subgroup 1: Catholic Churches. The materials in this subgroup date from 1903 to 2015. Series, subseries and files are arranged by church and then document genre. All groupings are presented alphabetically. Files are ordered chronologically or alphabetically where applicable. Notable materials include: photographs of St. Mary's Catholic Chapel, annual reports from Immaculate Conception and newspaper articles highlighting the establishment of the Holy Cross Church.

Series 1.1: Holy Cross. The materials in this series date from 1966 to 1982. Subseries are arranged by document genre and then into file groupings by document function. All materials are presented alphabetically. Notable materials include: photographs of the exterior and interior of the church.

Series 1.2: Immaculate Conception. The materials in this series date from 1903 to 2015. Subseries are arranged by document genre and then into file groupings by document function. All materials are presented alphabetically. Notable materials include: photographs of the exterior and interior of the church and newspaper articles about past pastors and their lives.

Subgroup 2: Protestant Churches. The materials in this subgroup date from 1903 to 2015. Series, subseries, subsubseries and files are arranged by church, document genre and then finally by document function. The order of materials at the file level is chronological or alphabetical where appropriate. Notable materials include: The Parish Visitor newspaper from the Evangelical Congregational Church, newspaper articles about the groundbreaking for the Easton Baptist Church and anniversary booklets from the Lutheran Lebanon Church.

Series 2.1: Congregational. The materials in this series date from 1821 to 2014.. Subseries, subsubseries and file groupings are arranged by church and then document genre. All materials are presented alphabetically. File groupings are reflective of document function and are ordered either chronologically or alphabetically depending on the prevalence of dated materials. A notable item are the anniversary booklets from the Covenant Congregational Church.

Series 2.2: Baptist. The materials in this series date from 1974 to 2012. Subseries and subsubseries are arranged by church and then document genre. All materials are ordered chronologically or alphabetically depending on the prevalence of dates. Notable materials include photographs of the exterior and interior of the Old Baptist Church on Center Street and Columbus Avenue.

Series 2.3: Episcopal. The materials in this series date from 1919 to 2015. Subseries and subsubseries are arranged by church and then document genre. All materials are presented alphabetically and ordered chronologically where dates are present. Notable materials include: the Church Quest Book, the Remembrance Book and the Briggs Award for Preservation.

Series 2.4: Lutheran. The materials in this series date from 1873 to 2009. Subseries, subsubseries and file level groupings are arranged by church and document genre. Files are specifically arranged by further divisions in document genre. All materials are presented alphabetically, except for those that lack dates. Notable materials include the monthly letters to the Lutheran Lebanon congregation.

Series 2.5: Methodist. The materials in this series date from 1863 to 2014. Subseries, and subsubseries are arranged by church and document genre. File level groupings are arranged by creator or document function where appropriate. All materials are presented alphabetically, except for those that lack dates. Notable materials include correspondence between the Central Methodist Church and its parishioners, and Sunday School papers relating to Fred King.

Series 2.6: Presbyterian. The materials in this series are undated. There is only one church that falls within this denomination, therefore there is only one subseries. No further divisions were necessary. All materials are ordered by document genre and presented chronologically when possible. Notable materials include photographs of the Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church.

Series 2.7: Miscellaneous Churches. The materials in this series date from 1962 to an unknown date. Subseries are arranged by church and are ordered alphabetically. No further divisions were necessary and all foldered materials are presented chronologically where appropriate. Notable materials include photographs of the exterior of the Church of the Nazarene and an academic report about Foursquare and its practices.

Subgroup 3: Independent Churches. The materials in this subgroup date from 1919 to 2011. Series and subseries are arranged by church and document genre. All materials are presented alphabetically, with subseries being ordered chronologically where possible. Notable materials include: newspaper articles about the Torahs being brought to Chayai Shalom, academic reports about the history of Christianity in Easton and photographs of the exterior of the New Hope Christain Chapel.

Series 3.1: Chayai Shalom. The materials in this series date from 1996 to 2010. There are no subseries due to the few materials present. There are no particularly notable items in this series due to its small size.

Series 3.2: Free Evangelical Fellowship. The materials in this series date from 1995. There are no subseries due to the few materials present. The most notable materials are photographs of the exterior of the building.

Series 3.3: General History. The materials in this series date from 1967 to an unknown date. Subseries are arranged by document genre and presented alphabetically. All materials within subseries are ordered chronologically where dates are present. The most notable item is the 250th Anniversary of Easton booklet.

Series 3.4: Society of Friends (Quaker). The materials in this series are undated. There are no subseries due to the few materials present. There are no particularly notable items in this series due to its small size.

Series 3.5: Unitarian. The materials in this series date from 1974 and cover only a small portion of this denomination in Easton. Therefore, there are no subseries necessary. There are no particularly notable items in this series due to its small size.

Series 3.6: Water's Church. The materials in this series date from 1919 to an unknown date. There are no subseries due to the few materials present. There are no particularly notable items in this series due to its small size.

Subgroup 4: Miscellaneous Materials. The materials in this series date from an 1924 to 2011. Series are arranged by document genre and presented alphabetically. All materials within the series are ordered chronologically where dates are present. There are no particularly notable materials in this subgroup.

Series 4.1: Documents. The materials in this series date from an unknown date to 2011. There are no subseries due to the few materials present. There are no particularly notable items in this series due to its small size.

Series 4.2: Photographs. The materials in this series are undated. There are no subseries due to the few materials present. There are no particularly notable items in this series due to its small size.
